Terry Fuller, Code Enforcement Officer, submitted a written report of permits issued and inspections done in April, The letters to residents in violation of the Property Maintenance Law have been mailed. Notices to taxpayers for trailer permits have been sent also.

Bonnie Rae Strickland, Assessor sent a written report by email. Board of Assessment Review will be May 28, 2020 from 4-8 PM. Those appearing will be asked to enter one at a time and must wear a mask due to the Covid-19 pandemic. NYS is encouraging taxpayers to choose STAR credit rather than STAR exemption on school taxes by allowing increases in STAR credit in future years while the STAR exemption will never increase.

Eric Butler, Dog Control Officer no report.

Jason Pearl, Highway Superintendent, reported that the employees were called back to work just last week. The layoff of all employees was a NYS ordinance due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

Mary Weber, Town Clerk and Tax Collector, give a written report of fees collected in March and April and a brief oral report about tax collection. The Supervisor was presented with a check for \$23.62 for fees collected in March and \$3.79 for fees collected in April. The check from tax collection totaled \$1805.31 for interest and penalties collected with taxes in February and March 2020.

Carrie Childs Supervisor, reported Bank Balances April and had received a check

totaling \$4,622.95 for Mortgage Tax. Workers Compensation Insurance will be refunding 2% of premium paid due to the mandatory layoff caused by the Corvid-19 pandemic. Court records will be reviewed by the accountants for the annual audit,

Alan Morton moved to accept the officers reports as presented, the second was made by Nancy Frazier and carried by all 4 votes in favor.

Carrie Childs moved to accept the minutes from the March and April meetings as presented, the second was made by Nancy Frazier and motion carried by all 4 votes in favor.

General Fund invoices #43-51 totaling \$1299.85 and Highway Fund invoices #62-76 totaling \$6155.62 were circulated and signed.
