PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD:

The Annual Discissions were review line by line. Josh Freunds Schuh moved to adopt the discissions, the second was made by David Moshier and carried by all 4 votes in favor. The Agreement for the Expenditure of Highway Moneys was circulated and signed and will be submitted to the County Superintendent for approval. A copy of the decisions follows these minutes.

Bonnie Rae Strickland, Assessor, submitted a written report: 2020 tax roll updated with new owners and addresses. The Assessor will be in the office on Tuesday Jan 12, in the evening to meet with any taxpayer that might have questions or concerns.

Terry Fuller, Code Enforcement Officer, submitted a written report of permits issued and certificates of compliance. The clerk was presented with \$40.00 for fees collected in December 2020.

Eric Butler, Dog Control Officer no report.

Jason Pearl, Highway Superintendent, submitted a written report noting that the new employee has been working and is doing well. The workers installed a 40ft driveway pipe on Bozard Hill as requested by the property owner.

The Town Clerk presented a report for December. The Supervisor was given a

check for \$456.54. An error on the funds collected in November was corrected. The \$126.00 had been allocated to building permits and should have been allocated to hunting licenses. The Supervisor was also presented with a check for \$10,15 from interest in the tax collection checking account in 2020.

Carrie Childs, Supervisor, presented a written report, including bank balances. A check from NY State for \$3,066.00 was received on 12/28/2020.

David Moshier moved to accept the officers reports as presented, the second was made by Joshua Freundschuh, and carried by all 4 votes in favor.

Joshua Freundschuh moved to approve the minutes from the November meeting the motion was seconded by David Moshier and carried by 4 votes in favor.

David Moshier moved to accept the minutes from the December meeting as submitted, the second came from Joshua Freundschuh, and the motion was carried by all 4 votes in favor.

Old Business: The cameras have not yet been purchased. No response from the attorney concerning a natural cemetery at this date.

New Business: none

General Fund invoices #140-143 for 2020 totaling \$\$499,81 and #1-8 for 2021 totaling \$10,378.55 were circulated. Highway Fund invoices #170-177 totaling \$7560.8 for 2020 and #1-4 totaling \$38,821.30 for 2021 were circulated.

Carrie Childs moved

to pay the bills as presented, second by Alan Morton and the motion was carried by all 4 votes in favor.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:40 P.M. by a motion from Carrie Childs, seconded by Josh Freundschuh, and carried by 4 in favor.
