Bonnie Rae Strickland, Assessor, submitted a written report and will be available on the Tuesday following the Board Meeting each month from 5:30-7 PM.

Terry Fuller, Code Enforcement Officer, submitted a written report of permits issued and certificates of compliance. The clerk was presented with \$40.00 for fees collected in January 2021.

Eric Butler, Dog Control Officer no report.

Jason Pearl, Highway Superintendent, submitted a written report noting that the employees have taken the Comp Training for Violence in the Workplace.

The Town Clerk presented a report for January 2021. The Supervisor was given a check for \$56.00 for building permits and dog licenses.

Old Business: The cameras have not yet been purchased. No response from the attorney concerning a natural cemetery at this date.

New Business: Proposed Local Law #1 2021 providing that no exemption be applicable on solar or wind energy systems. The law was adopted by Cattaraugus County. Josh Freundschuh moved to adopt the Law for the Town of Humphrey, the second was made by David Moshier and the roll call vote recorded as:

The law will be presented to the attorney to edit and submit to the State of New York.

David Moshier moved to adopt the 2021 Cattaraugus County Hazard Mitigation Plan as the jurisdiction's Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan. The second was made by Josh Freundschuh and the motion as carried by 3 votes in favor 2 absent.

General Fund invoices #9-20 totaling \$2,924.79 and Highway Fund invoices #5*29 totaling \$26,498.29 were circulated and signed.

Carrie Childs moved to pay the bills as presented, second by David Moshier and the motion was carried by 3 votes in favor.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:10 P.M. by a motion from Carrie Childs, seconded by Josh Freundschuh, and carried by 3 in favor.
